CONTEXT

The site extends to approximately 13ha and is situated within the Parish of Preston which immediately adjoins the settlement boundary of Cirencester.

The site is proposed to meet the housing land supply shortfall of Cotswold District Council between 2023 and 2031 and will provide a range and mix of housing including affordable homes.

INTRODUCTION

An application for outline planning permission (with all matters reserved) for a residential development of up to 280 dwellings on Land West of Kingshill Lane near Cirencester is being prepared. As a part of this the views of local people are being sought on the proposals.
